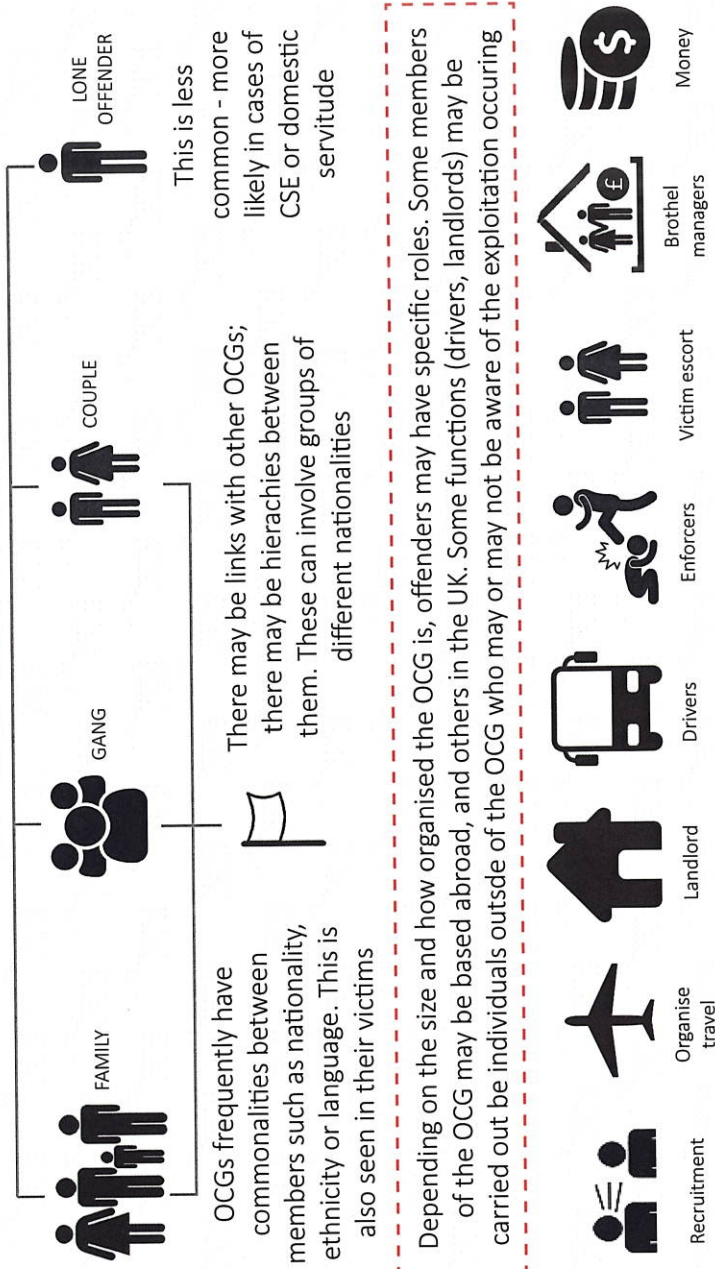


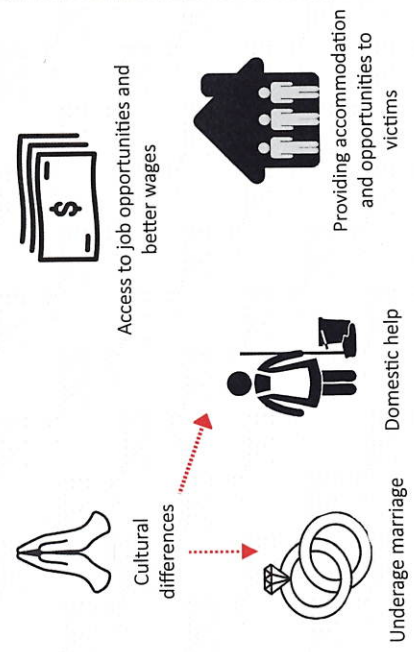
ORGANISATION

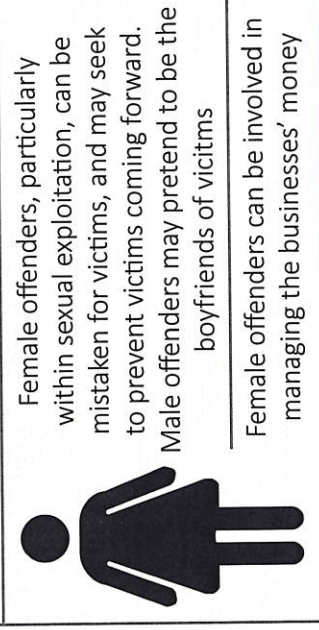
OFFENDER RATIONALE

Offenders may use the below as explanation to allegations of Modern Slavery

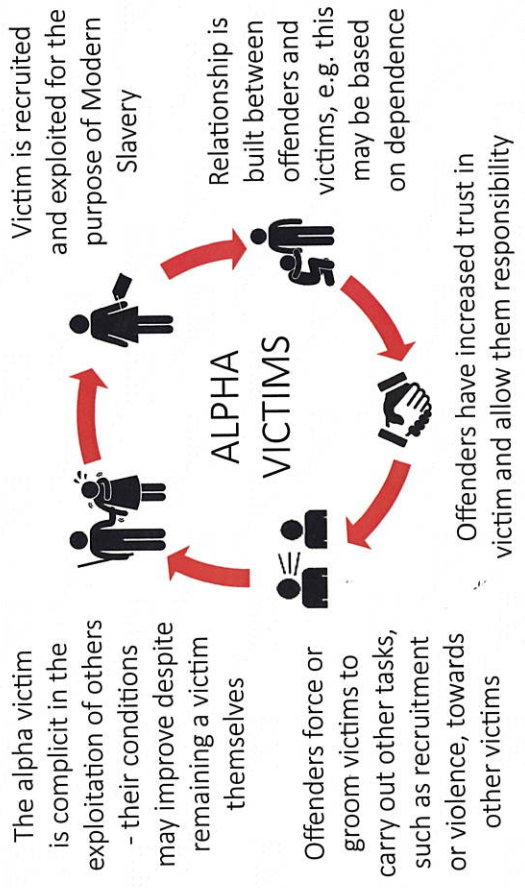


GENDER

Offenders may be male or female. Males are more likely to offend with other males or with females. It is less likely that females will offend with solely other females

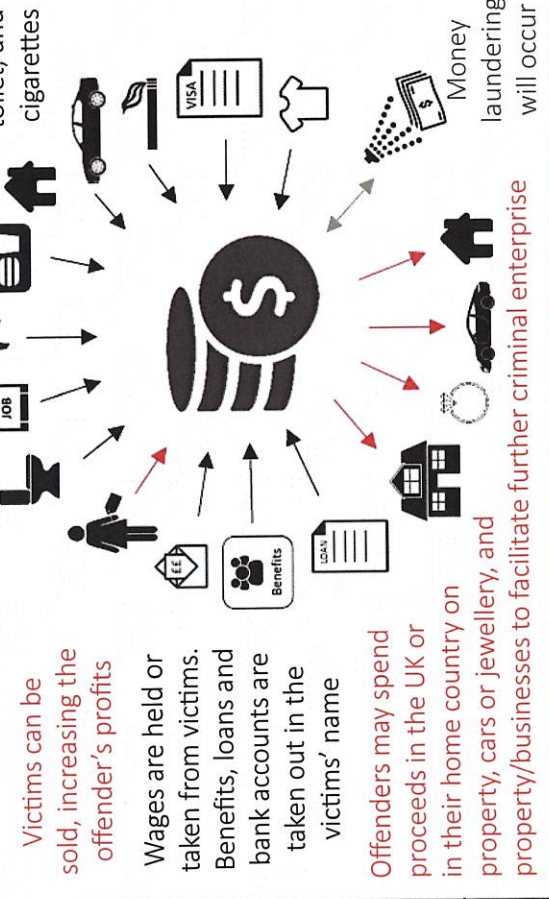


ALPHA VICTIMS

Offenders can generate money from slavery and trafficking in many ways



Offenders charge victims for everyday items, depleting their wages or increasing debt bondage, e.g. transport to the UK, finding work, charging for visas, transport to work, food, rent, using the toilet, and cigarettes
